The feature of our sale is an auction of 130 polls and merinos specially selected as stud and commercial sires. There is a noticeable increase in numbers of those rams in the 21-22µm range but there is still the very soft pure white crimpy 19-20µm ram. We will replace the mini auction this year with about 80 price-graded rams for private selection, after the sale or in the weeks ahead.

A feature of our strain of terminal rams is low lamb birth weight and rapid early growth as many of our clients could testify to. Many comment that the long lamb bodies really weigh well.
